What did Nathanael say and do after Philip told him about Jesus?</li><li>2. What did Jesus tell Nathanael that surprised him?</li><li>3. How does it make you feel to know that Jesus already knows and loves you too?</li></ol>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Week 2</b> <b>A story of two sisters</b> <b>Luke 10:38-42</b></p> <p>Questions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Why was Martha upset at Mary?</li><li>2. What did Jesus say to Mary and what was he trying to teach her and us?</li><li>3. What are different ways that you see people serve God? Is one way better than the other?</li></ol>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Week 3</b> <b>Jesus is Tempted</b> <b>Matthew 4:1-11</b></p> <p>Questions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Why was Satan tempting Jesus?</li><li>2. What things did Satan tempt Jesus to do?</li><li>3. How did Jesus respond and what does this show us about the kind of king Jesus is?</li></ol>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Week 4</b> <b>Jesus' hometown does not accept him</b> <b>Matthew 13:53-58</b></p> <p>Questions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Where was Jesus at when he was teaching in the synogague?</li><li>2. Why did the people not accept him?</li><li>3. Jesus was often rejected and not liked. How do you think this felt? How can this help you when you feel alone?</li></ol>
