Do you think Jesus is trustworthy and what helps you know he is who he says he is?	<p>Week 2 John 7:25-31 Jesus' time had not yet come</p> <p>Questions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Why were people angry with Jesus?2. What did Jesus tell them about who he is?3. Why do you think the people couldn't hurt Jesus even though some wanted and tried to?
<p>Week 3 Matthew 5:38-42 An eye for an eye, a tooth for a tooth</p> <p>Questions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. What does, "an eye for an eye, and a tooth for a tooth" mean?2. What is Jesus telling us about how to show others what God's love is like?3. Jesus is teaching us to be kind even when someone else isn't being kind to us.
